- 1. How does the Treaty of Paris outline the desired nature of the relationship between Great Britain and the United States of America?
 - The Treaty references that both countries wish to restore peace and harmony in addition to a level of mutual friendship, intercourse, correspondence, and respect.
- 2. Who were 3 American delegates who approved the Treaty?
 - John Adams, Benjamin Franklin, and John Jay.

- 3. Why do you think the Treaty outlined the land specifically owned by the United States?
 - Britain still controlled land in North America, therefore the borders of each nation's land needed to be established to prevent territorial disputes.

 - No. The Treaty says that nobody should be persecuted for the role they took in the war.
- 5. Does the Treaty allow for British soldiers to remain occupying the United States of America?
 - No, they must return to Great Britain.
