NOVEMBER 20, 1776

After the capture of Fort Washington, Cornwallis crosses the North River and moves south to Fort Lee.

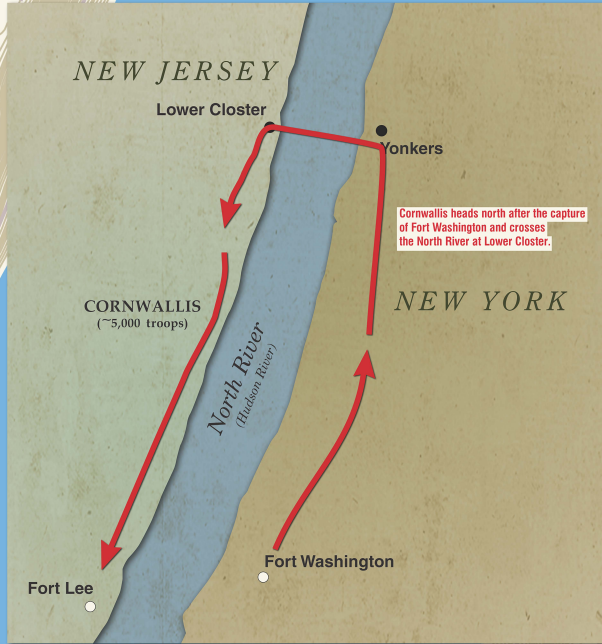
