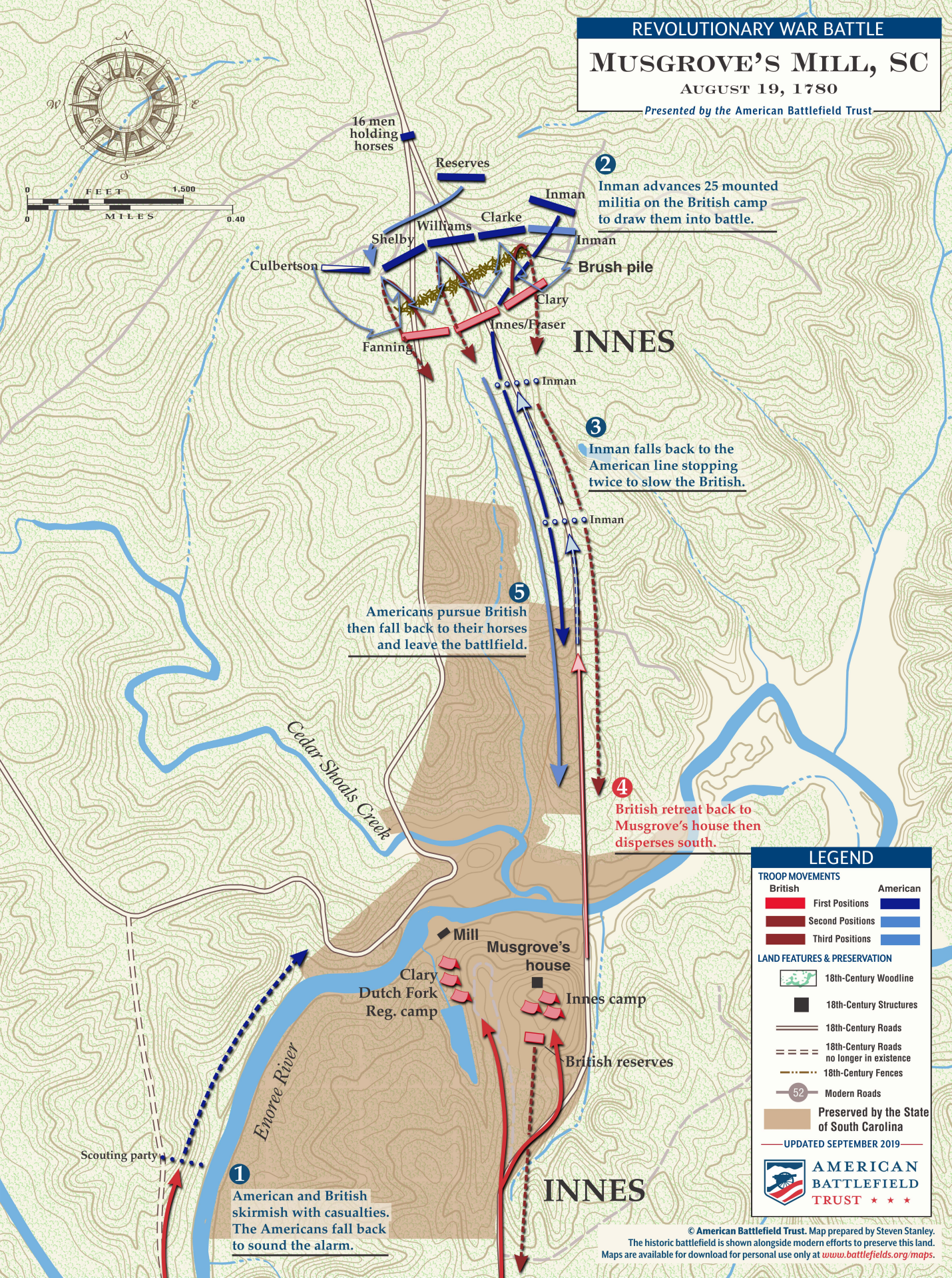


# MUSGROVE'S MILL, SC

AUGUST 19, 1780

**1** American and British skirmish with casualties. The Americans fall back to sound the alarm.

**2** Inman advances 25 mounted militia on the British camp to draw them into battle.

**3** Inman falls back to the American line stopping twice to slow the British.

**4** British retreat back to Musgrove's house then disperses south.

**5** Americans pursue British then fall back to their horses and leave the battlefield.
