UPDATED OCTOBER 2020



- Hessians push two guns up King Street. American artillery and fire from Mercer's infantry force them to abandon the guns.
- Rall leads his men behind St. Michael's Church for cover, combines with Lossberg, and are forced toward the American left flank.
- Washington shifts Hand/Haussegger to block Rall. The Hessians pull back to the apple orchard for cover.
- Rall leads his combined forces to recover his lost guns. They reach the guns under heavy fire from three sides.
- After reaching the town, St. Clair's brigade pours fire into Rall's flank.
- Stephen's troops charge the Hessians as they reach their guns.
- Rall is mortally wounded trying to recover his guns. Now leaderless and surrounded, the remaining Hessians surrender.
