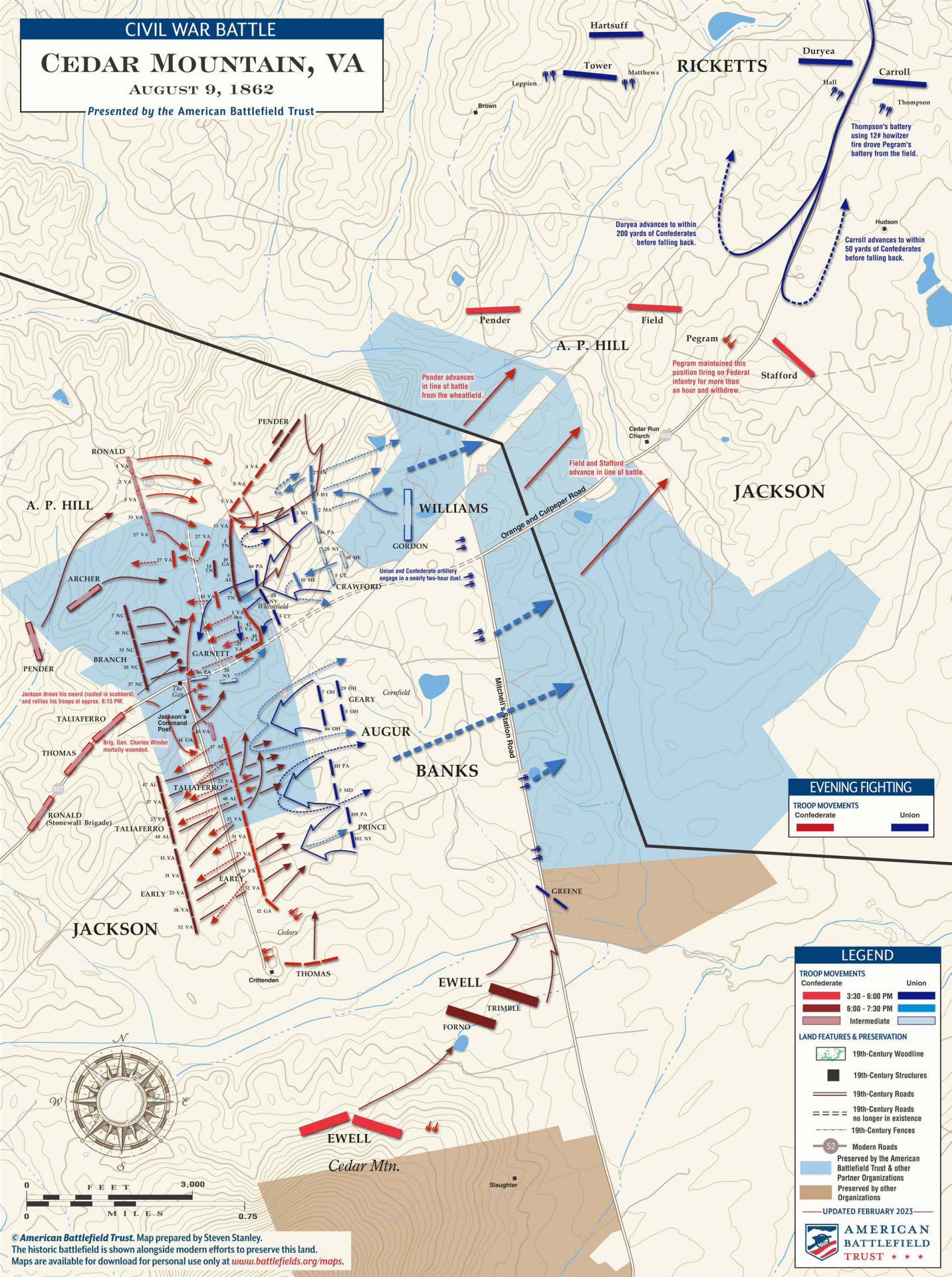


CIVIL WAR BATTLE

AUGUST 9, 1862

Pender advances in line of battle from the wheatfield.

Duryea advances to within 200 yards of Confederates before falling back.

Carroll advances to within 50 yards of Confederates before falling back.

Pegram maintained this position firing on Federal infantry for more than an hour and withdrew.

Field and Stafford advance in line of battle.

Jackson draws his sword (rustled in scabbard) and rallies his troops at approx. 6:15 PM.

Brig. Gen. Charles Winder mortally wounded.

Jackson's Command Post

Union and Confederate artillery engage in a nearly two-hour duel.

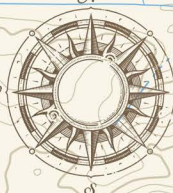
