• Loud Sound (can be heard on the march and in battle)	Played with wooden sticks

Music on the march RU	Marching Speed
Play Commands on the Battlefield	Assembly of Troops
Camp Tunes	 Set the speed for loading and firing weapons
Used for signaling orders within camp	Used for signaling orders within camp
