**PREVOST**  
(~870 troops)

**2** British landing party drives outnumbered American defenders across the causeway.

**1** The British attempt to land on the southern shore of Horse Island but are driven back by artillery and small arms fire.

**3** After retreating to their entrenchments, Americans rally to threaten the British right, causing them to halt and then withdraw completely, resulting in an American victory.
