Gordon's Brigade moves in support of Hays and Hoke.

After Hay's and Avery's men take the summit of East Cemetery Hill, Rodes' troops move out of Gettysburg and form on Long Lane, but fail to advance in support of Early's men.

A In his report, Hays did not give his alignment. This alignment is taken from Bachelder's July 2 map.

B Amsberg's brigade moves to Culp Hill in support of Greene just as Early starts his attack.
