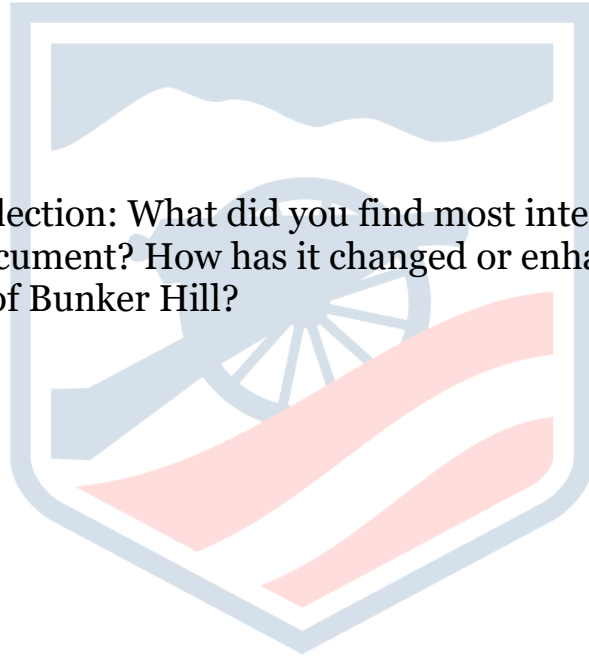
- b. Immediate Impact: Did this document have an immediate outcome on the Battle of Bunker Hill? Or is it recording a personal experience?
