- 1** A forward detachment of Armand's Cav. engage the British Legion Cav. then recoil to their main body.
- 2** British Legion Cav. strike Armand's Cav. then fall back.
- 3** Porterfield's VA Light Inf. advance to give supporting fire to Armand.
- 4** Smallwood's 1st MD forms a line of battle across the road.
- 5** British Light Inf. form a line of battle and advance on Smallwood.
- 6** Armstrong's east flankers, advance through heavy brush, and give supporting fire.
- 7** Both sides disengage, fall back and regroup.

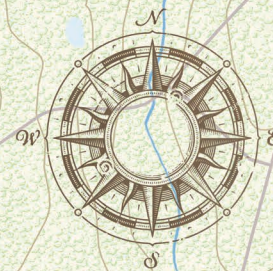
