 After spending 30-45 minutes searching Col. Barrett's farm, the British find no supplies and head back to Concord.

3
 Barrett musters his Minutemen in Brown's cow pasture.

4
 Barrett advances to the North Bridge.

1
 British forces arrive in Concord around 7:30 a.m. and 4 Companies of 120 men head to Col Barrett's farm in search of military supplies.

5
 British troops fall back across the North Bridge and defend the east side of the bridge.

6
 British troops retreat back to Boston.
