(~11,000 troops)

In an attempt to turn the flank of the Americans, Cornwallis sends his 3rd Brigade to attack the left of Washington's line. Lafayette's reserve line and Continental artillery turn them back.

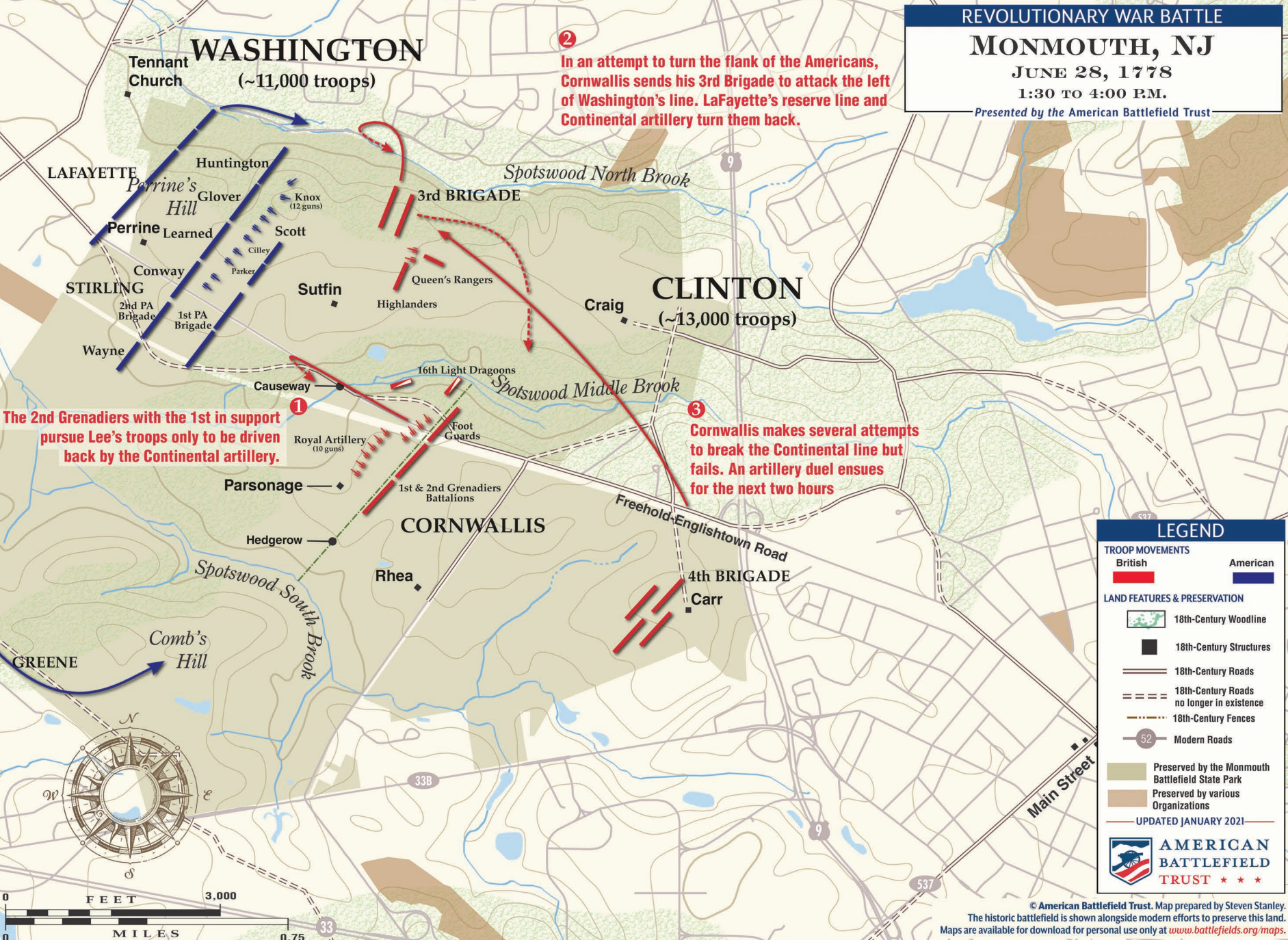
## CLINTON

(~13,000 troops)

Cornwallis makes several attempts to break the Continental line but fails. An artillery duel ensues for the next two hours.

The 2nd Grenadiers with the 1st in support pursue Lee's troops only to be driven back by the Continental artillery.
