## QUEBEC, CANADA

DECEMBER 31, 1775

- 1 Montgomery attacks the Pres de Ville. Montgomery is killed in the attack.
- 2 Arnold is wounded while attacking the first barricade.
- 3 Continental troops now under Morgan attack the second barricade. During the attack, British forces reoccupy the first barricade trapping the Americans.
