SEPTEMBER 1, 1862

After spotting Union forces, Jackson sends two brigades to investigate then deploys his entire wing into battle formation.

The westward extent of the Confederate line and the full area and direction of Birney's attack are not precisely known.

Poe arrives with his brigade.

Maj. Gen. Kearny arrives with Birney's large brigade.

Stevens advances his 3 brigades toward Jackson's Confederates. Followed by Ferrero's Brigade under Reno.

Ferrero's 2 regiments move to protect Stevens' flank, while the 51 PA stays west of the road to support Durell's battery.
