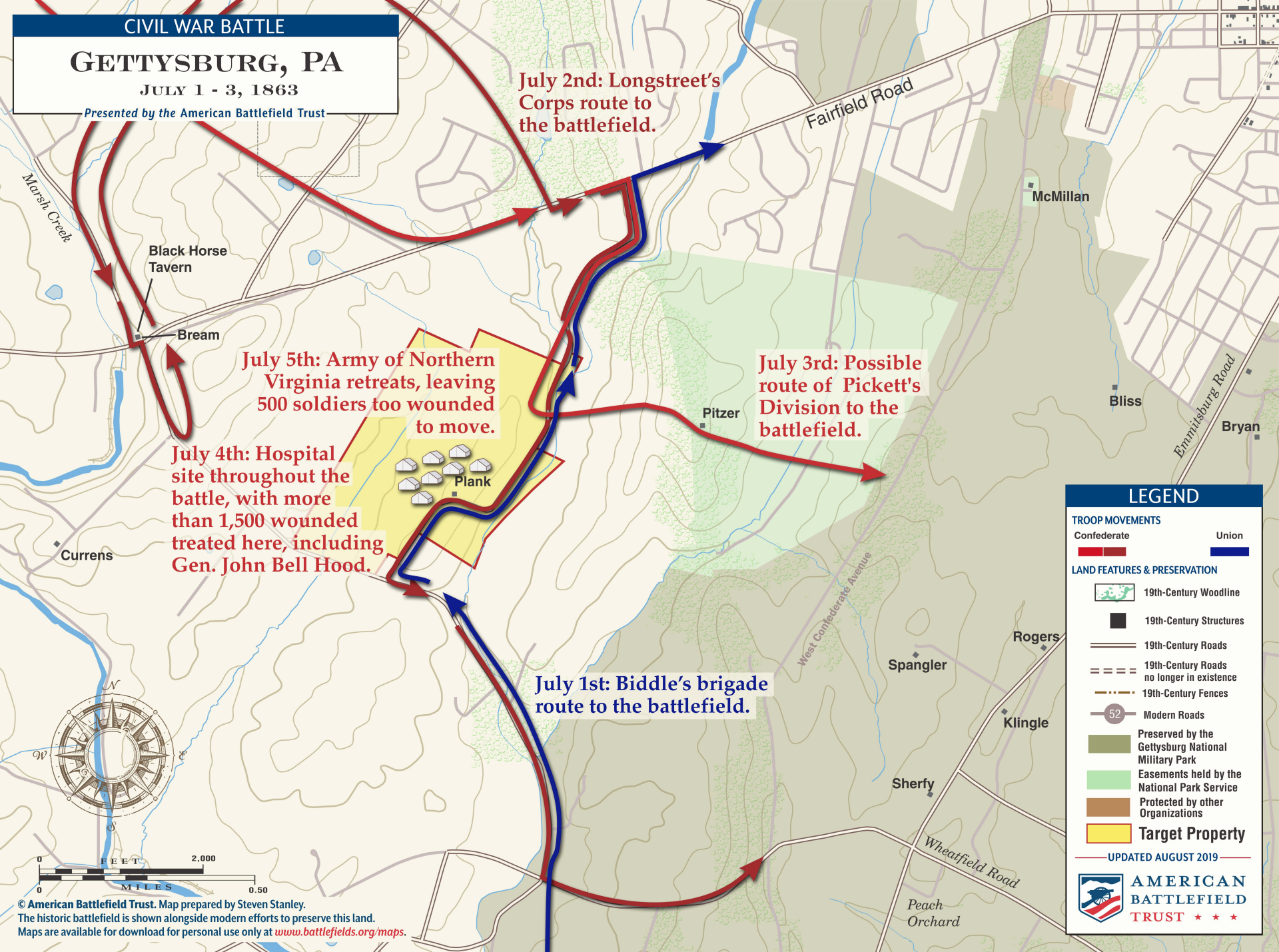


CIVIL WAR BATTLE

July 2nd: Longstreet's Corps route to the battlefield.

July 5th: Army of Northern Virginia retreats, leaving 500 soldiers too wounded to move.

July 4th: Hospital site throughout the battle, with more than 1,500 wounded treated here, including Gen. John Bell Hood.

July 3rd: Possible route of Pickett's Division to the battlefield.

July 1st: Biddle's brigade route to the battlefield.
