Clifton's Boiler is struck forcing crew to abandon ship.

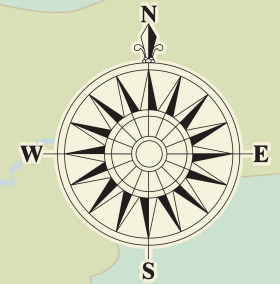
Aprox. 4 p.m. Sachem is hit and disabled.
